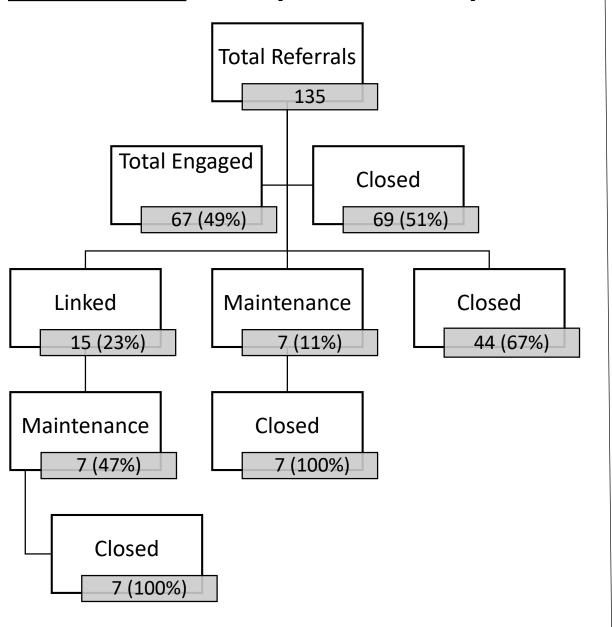


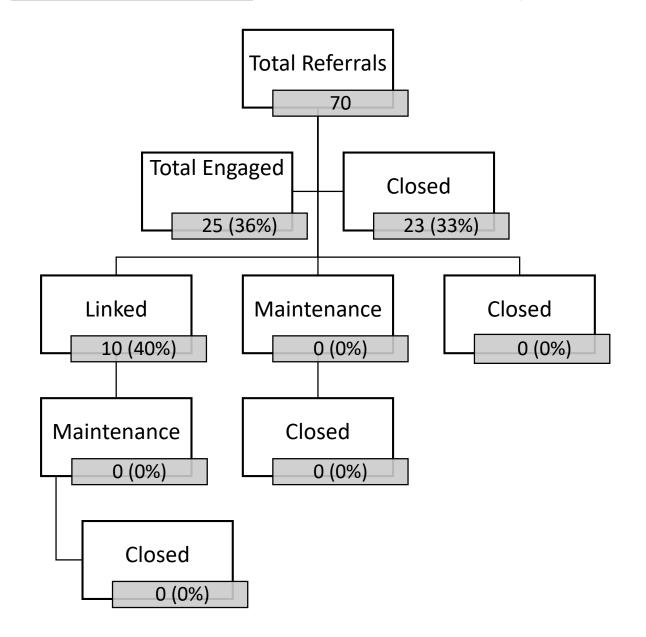

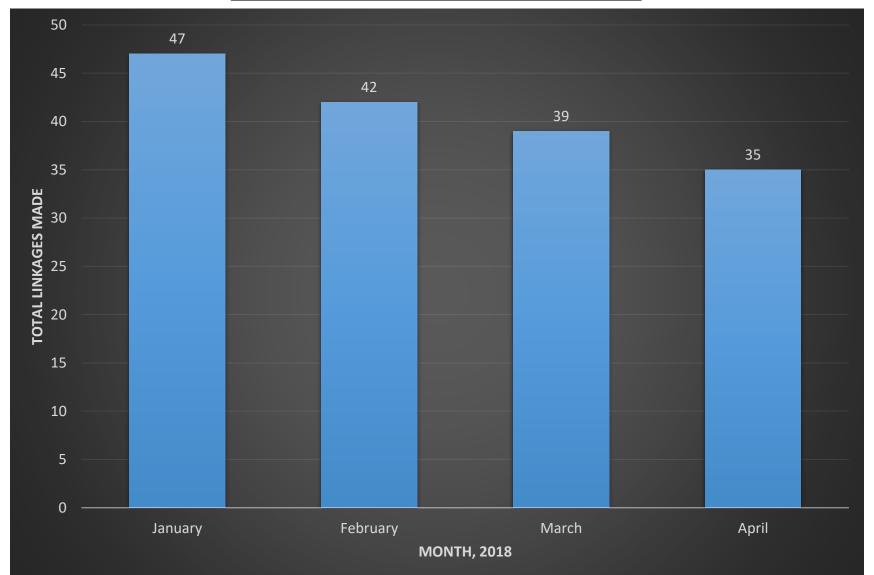

### 2018 FACE Linkages, by Month\*



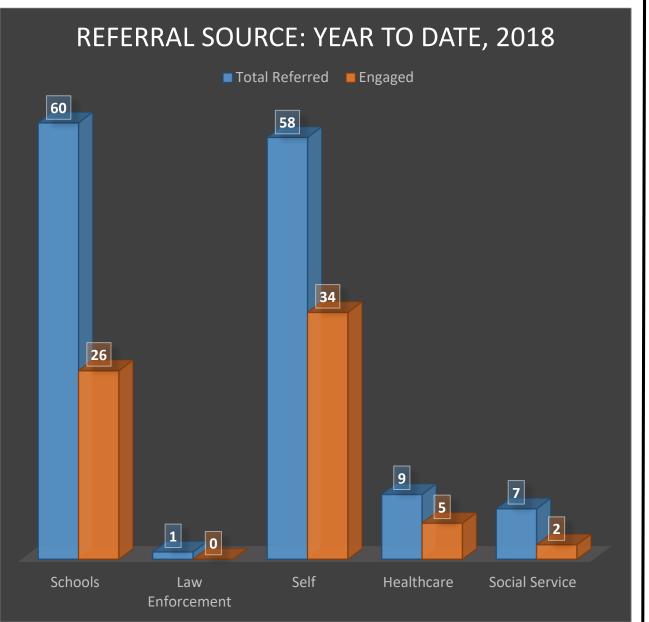

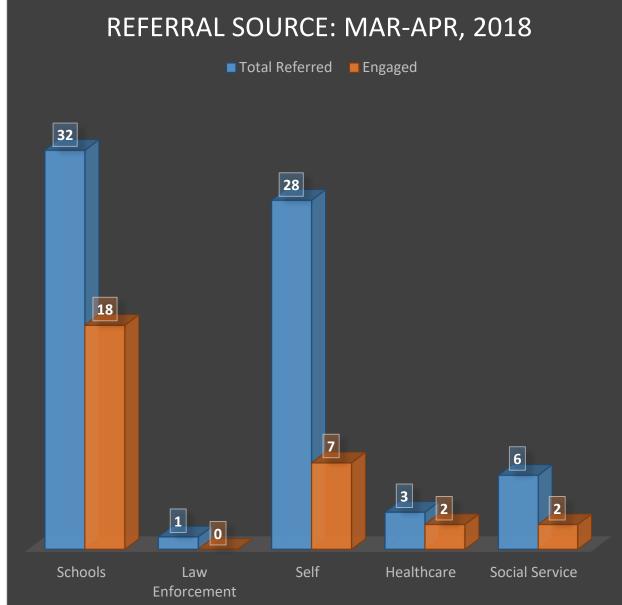


Demographics of FACE Families

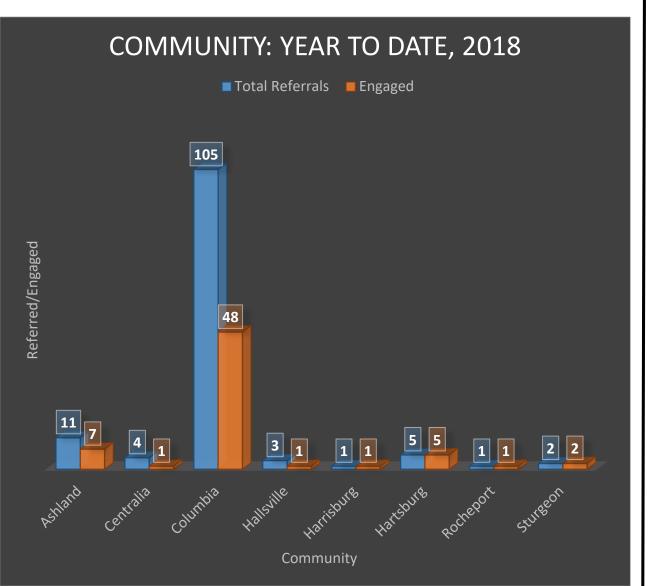


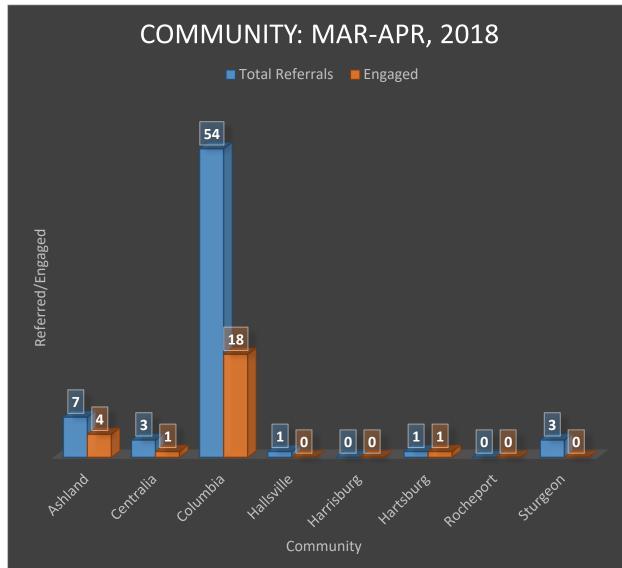
# Referral Source: Total and Engaged



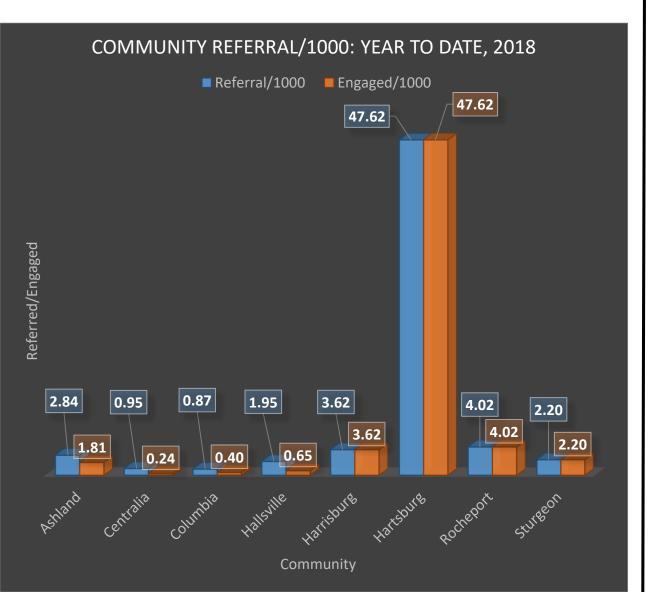


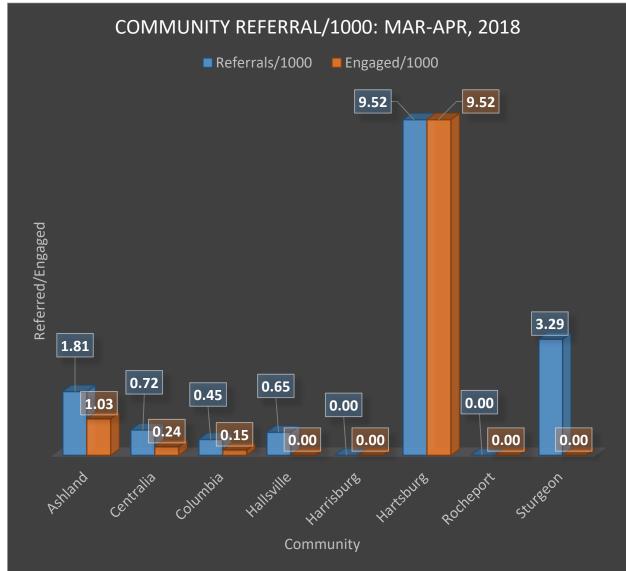
### Community Referral Source: Total and Engaged



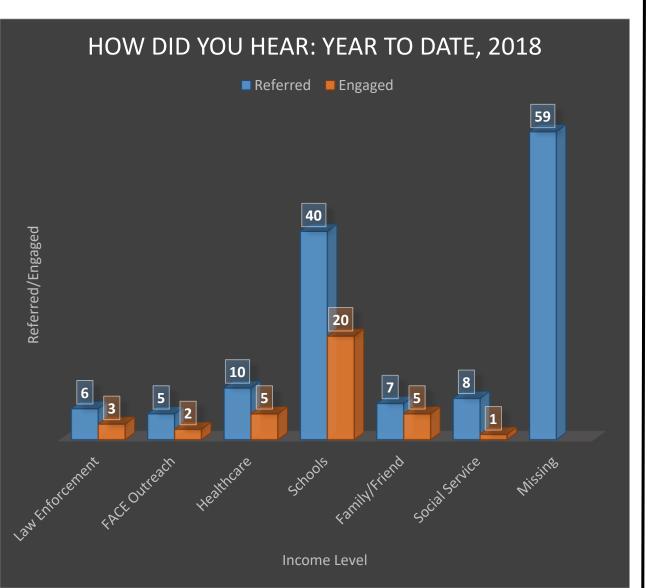


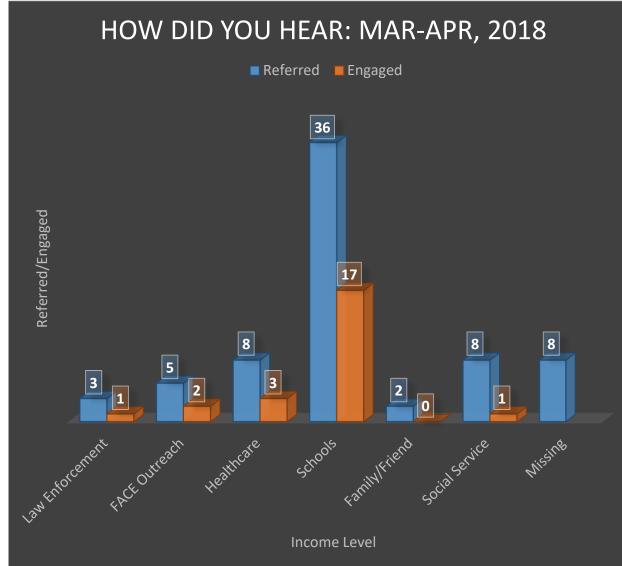
#### Community Referral Rate Per 1000 Residents: Total and Engaged



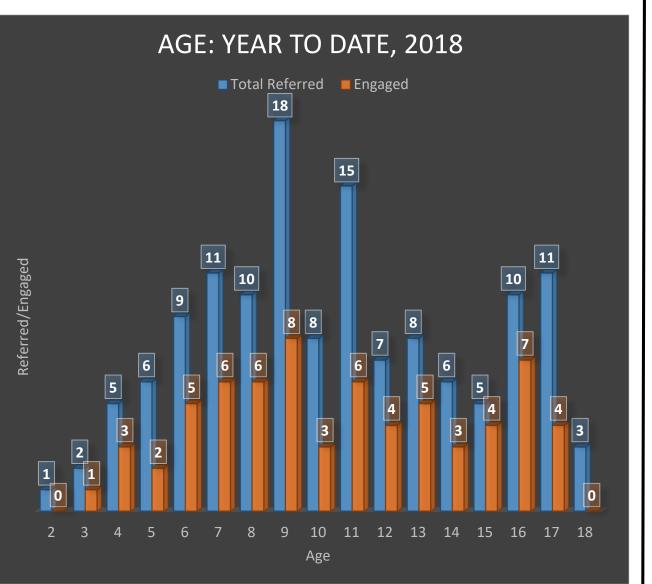


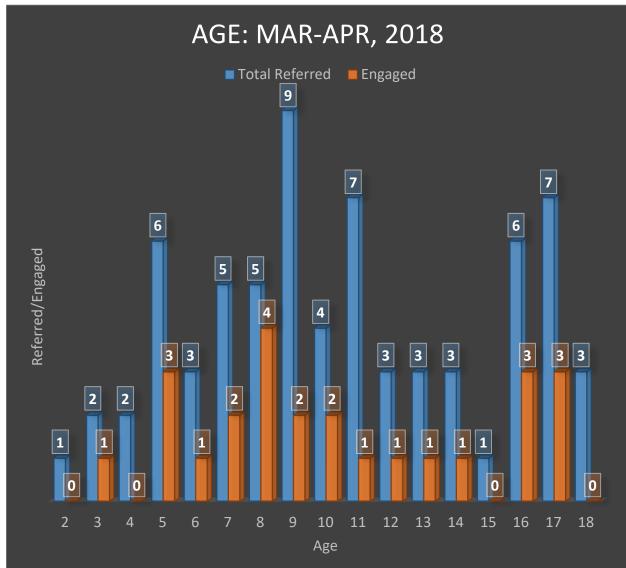
### How Did You Hear About FACE: Total and Engaged



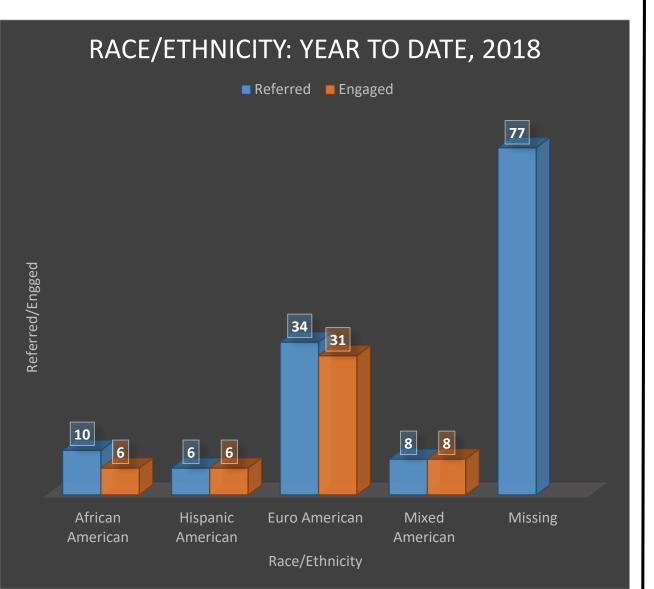


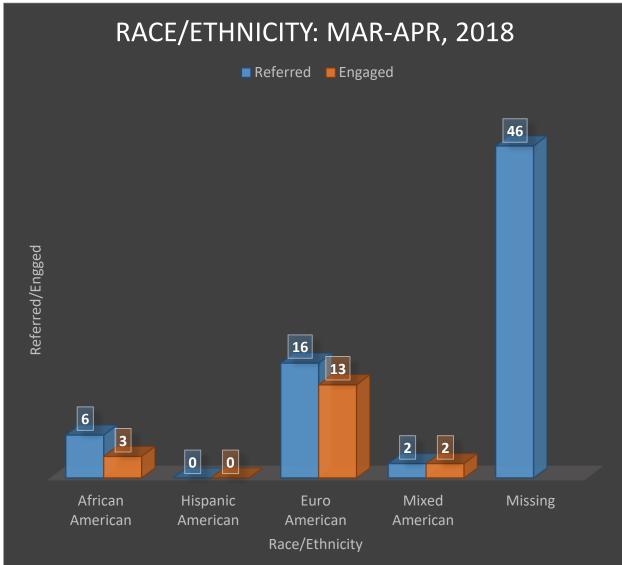
## Age of Child Referred: Total and Engaged (N=135)



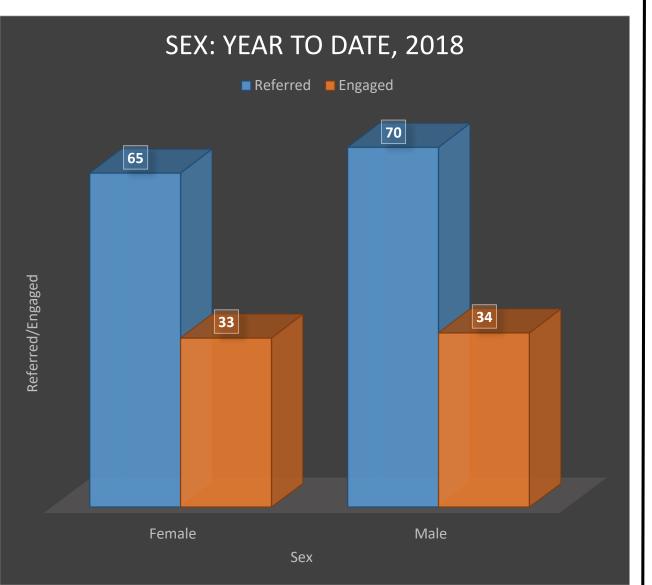


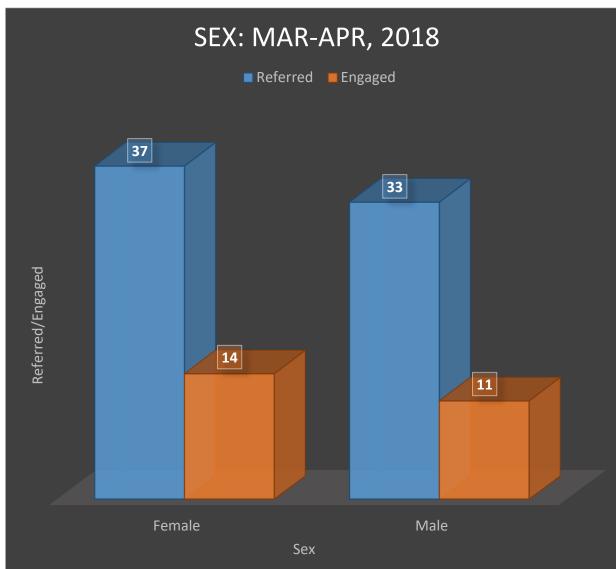
## Race/Ethnicity of Child Referred: Total and Engaged



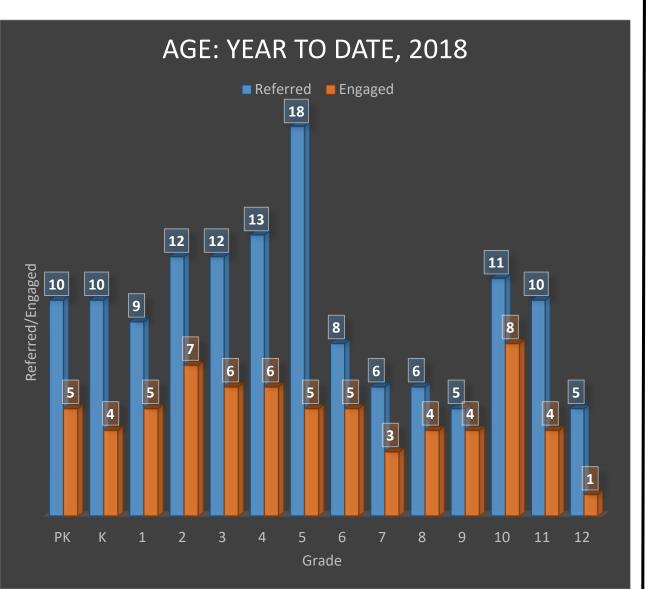


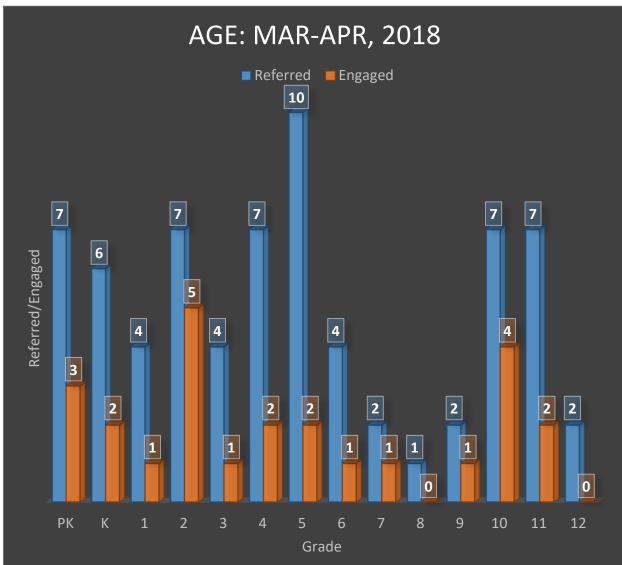
# Biological Sex of Child Referred: Total and Engaged



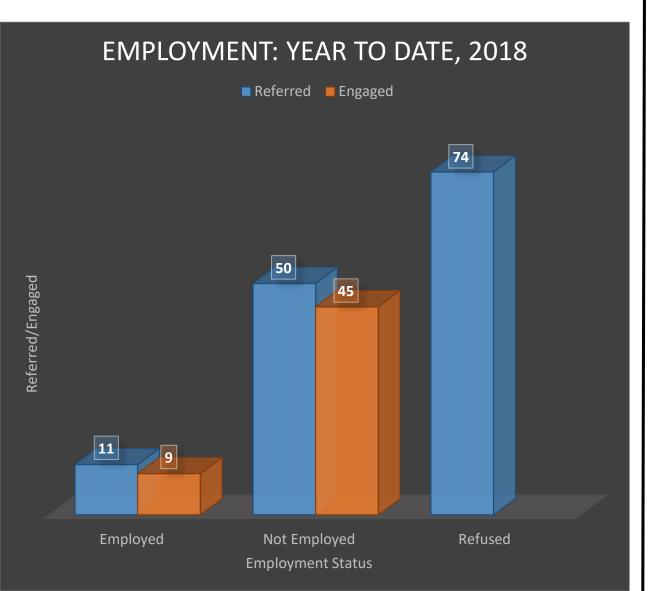


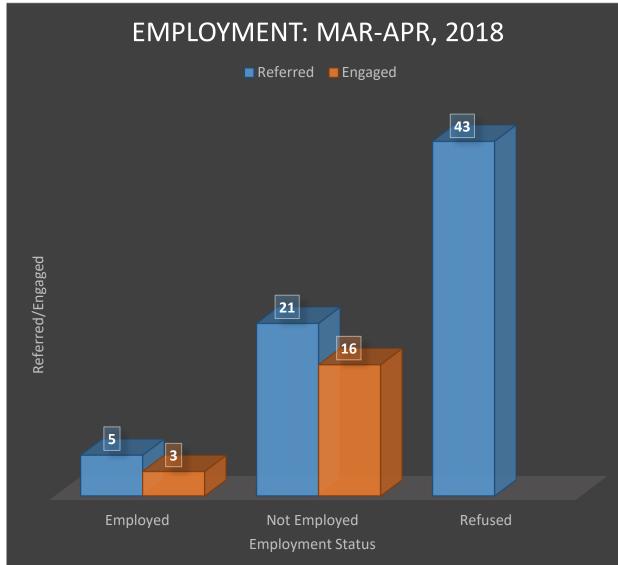

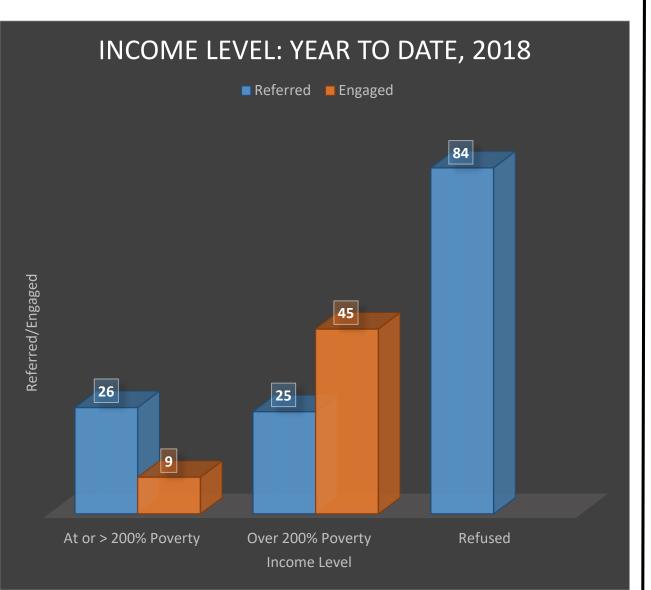


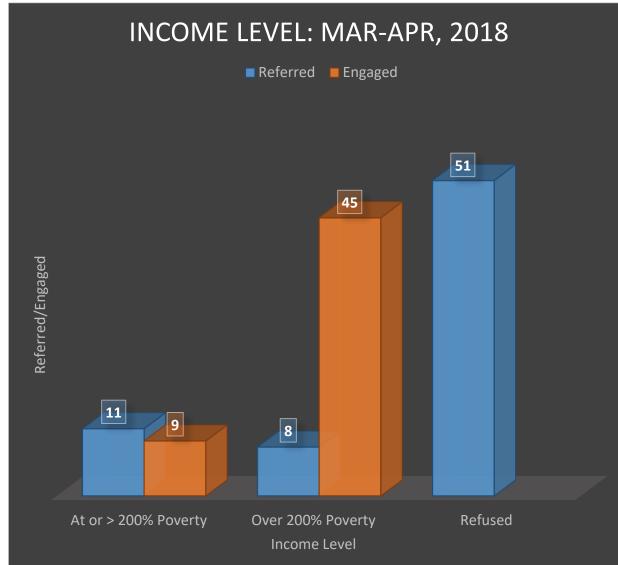
## Employment Status of Family: Total and Engaged (N=135)

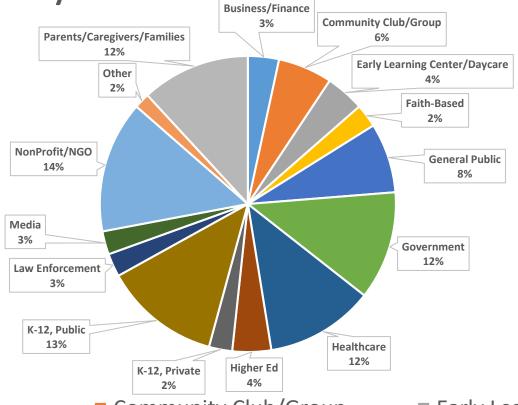

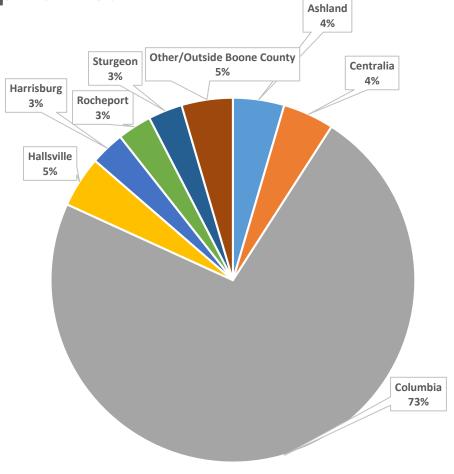

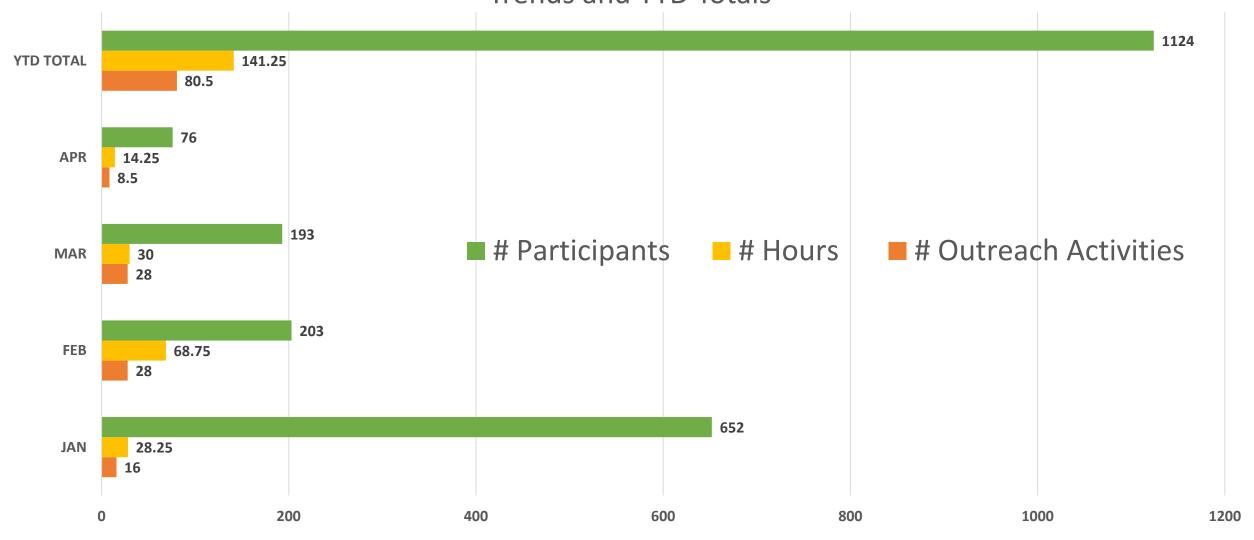

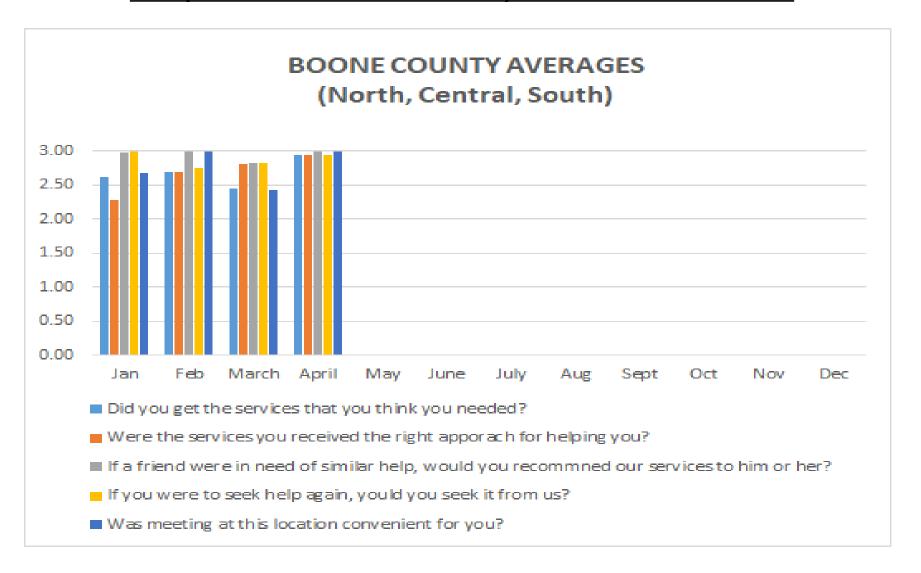




Family Satisfaction with FACE Services



#### Family Satisfaction Feedback Scores by Month & Year-to-Date 2018

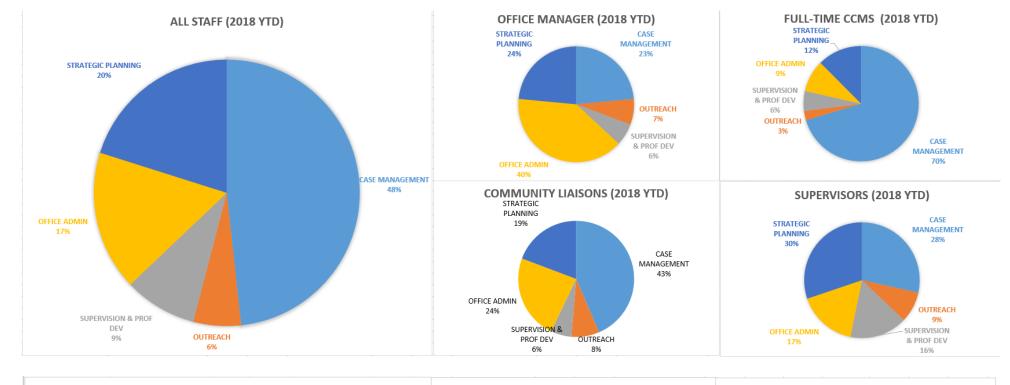




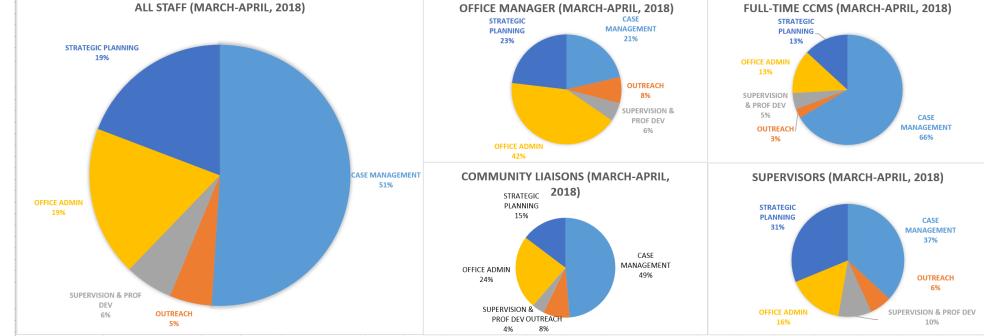
